This type of poetry always has four lines and rhymes in one of four ways. Poets use letters to show the pattern of rhyme. The four types of rhyme for a quatrain are: AABB, ABAB, ABBA, and ABCB.

leopard seal.

Line 4: describe the noun (four syllables)
